

STAY HEALTHY What is MPOX? Mpox is a viral zoonotic disease. Sustained person-to-person transmission has been confirmed outside of endemic areas. How it spreads Symptoms \bigcirc Intimate contact with an infected person or direct contact with patient's respiratory secretions, broken skin or mucous membranes, as well as contaminated objects Contact with infected \bigcirc Headache Fever animals Respiratory droplet transmission \bigcirc **Current situation** Mpox cases have been identified in many countries Swollen **Rash or** in Europe, the Americas and lymph nodes blisters other regions (shown on face, limbs, genitals) (neck, armpits, groin) Americas **Exhaustion Muscle aches**

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Mox Alert: Here's What You Should Do

There have been cases of Mpox reported in Taiwan. If you're planning to travel to areas with high prevalence or high-risk premises venues, avoid close contact with unknown people.

If you experience any symptoms, wear a mask and seek medical attention immediately. Inform your doctor about your travel history, history of exposure to high-risk premises venues, and contact history.
